

The End?

If you have been given this booklet it is because someone *really* loves and cares for you.

Don't get angry... read it!

Are you coming to THE END of your life? What do you think about regarding the future and what's ahead of you? Are you worried about entering the 'unknown' after death? You don't have to be. This booklet will clearly let you know what is ahead of you, if you're interested.

Life can seem so unfair at times. You may be terminally ill, or know someone who is, and all they want to do is stay alive, get cured and try to enjoy the rest of their life.

Even in a terrible circumstance such as this, God isn't in most people's thoughts sadly. The wicked, through the pride of his countenance, will not seek after God: God is not in all his thoughts. Psalm 10v4.

Do you think about God, life after death, Heaven and Hell, or do you get some sort of pleasure out of saying you're an atheist?

When death is staring people in the face and they have nothing to lose, only everything to gain, *still* they will not turn to God for help. The human heart is indeed very hard and rebellious at times. **The heart is deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked: who can know it?** Jeremiah 17v9.

I know a man, who throughout all his life was so 'anti'

God, he wanted nothing to do with Him or the Bible, and only used His name as blasphemy. He couldn't care less to know that **Jesus Christ took his sins and died in his place**. This particular man had a successful career in the world's eyes; he got married, had two children, later divorced, went on to lose his *successful* job, yet all the while he kept his health. Now he is in his eighties and very frail, *he's just waiting to die*. He can only talk about the past, as he sees no future after death. This is where he is so wrong.

Sure he has *lived*, and gone through the same kind of things that you and I go through, but now he is at the end of his life and has very little to look forward to. *Death awaits him*, and this scares him, not knowing how he will die, or what is beyond the grave. Each day he goes for a walk, sits in his chair, and lays in his bed, *just thinking*. I wonder what is going through his mind. Can you relate to this? Is this you, or someone you know? This kind of person is oftentimes very sombre and negative, and feels disillusioned about the way life has turned out for them.

The Bible states that Jesus Christ, who is God in the flesh (1 Timothy 3v16), became a man and took our sins upon Himself, died and was judged in our place, rising again the third day, so that all those who put their faith and trust in Him for their sins forgiven, can

go to Heaven when they die. Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood, he (Jesus Christ) also himself likewise took part of the same; that through death he might destroy him that had the power of death, that is, the devil; And deliver them who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage. Hebrews 2v14+15. Jesus Christ took away the fear of death and paved a way, where all those who believe and put their faith in Him, have assurance that when they die, Heaven awaits them, instead of Hell for those who reject Him. (John 3v18+36).

We all want perfect health, and to live forever with our loved ones, who doesn't, yet this becomes a *reality* only in Heaven, but to get there you have to do as God says, and that is to trust in the Lord Jesus Christ, for your sins forgiven, it's the *only* way. Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me. John 14v6. For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus; 1 Timothy 2v5. Religion cannot save you, neither can you work your way to Heaven by doing 'good deeds.' Only Jesus Christ can save you, as the truth is in Jesus (Ephesians 4v21). Have you called upon Him for salvation?

You may be reading this booklet having rejected God

all your life. You may believe in evolution rather than God's creation, thinking the scientists have got it right, rather than trusting in the Bible and believing what it says. Well friend, you are in for the shock of your life when you die, I promise you. This is your wake-up call, maybe your last chance of getting saved, don't mess it up now, because *the end* is near. There is no need to fear death or what is ahead of you, 'IF' you are trusting the Lord Jesus Christ and what He has done for you on the Cross. If I die today, I shall be carried by angels into the glory of Heaven, all because I believed the Gospel that Jesus died, was buried, and rose again.

There is absolutely *nothing* you can do to stay alive forever, **you are going to die**, have you thought about *that day*? Ever thought about your funeral and who would come and what they would say about you? Who will miss you? *Will you be missed*? If not, why not? Now is not the time to dwell on the past and regrets, as we've all got them. Now is the time to concentrate on the future... where will you spend eternity, Heaven or Hell? Have you rejected Jesus Christ, or received Him as your Saviour? **But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name**. John 1v12.

If you have rejected God and die in your sins, then you will go to Hell for eternity with no hope of escape. You

may disbelieve this, that doesn't matter, it's what the Bible says, and the Bible is true. You may get angry with that statement and start ranting and swearing, this is futile. You are going to die and if you die without God forgiving your sins, Hell awaits you. It's too late for you then. You now know the truth, it's up to you what you do with it. Do you understand how important this is?

The man I started telling you about, is my own dad. He has rejected God all his life thinking he knows best. He gets angry every time I bring up the subject of God, as he wants nothing to do with Him. In his early days, he was a strong, powerful and very opinionated man. Now he is very frail, yet still holding onto the same resentment towards the Lord as ever before. Why? What will he gain by not listening? What will you gain? I love my dad, and only want to see him get saved and go to Heaven, but it's his choice.

Many old people become stubborn and will not listen, they think they know it all. I sat with a man not too long ago, who only had a few weeks to live. I asked him whether he had ever put his faith and trust in the Lord Jesus Christ asking for his sins to be forgiven? He said that he didn't believe in God and it was too late for that now. I tried to reason with him, urging him to repent and ask God to forgive him, but he was having none of it. He just broke down and cried, not wanting

to die and leave his family, but he had no interest in my explanation that he *could* see his family again if he was going to go to Heaven. He didn't listen. A few weeks later he died, *in his sins*, as far as I know, without God and without hope. What a tragic story. He was in his final hour and threw his last chance away.

As I write this booklet, he is in Hell. Think about that for a while and understand the consequences of going your own way rather than the Lord's. There is a way which seemeth right unto a man, but the end thereof are the ways of death. Proverbs 14v12.

Truth is truth no matter what. Getting angry, swearing, cursing, and shouting that *you don't believe it, you don't care*, achieves nothing.

People will get so angry with me over this booklet that they'll tear it up and even post it back to me, yet all I am trying to do is save them from going to Hell, can you understand that?

I've spent time and money producing this booklet because I am so concerned that you'll die without Christ, and without Christ you are without hope. Please take heed to what is being said. The Bible is true.

I was once an unbelieving sinner, but I had an open

mind and weighed up all the evidence. Just by looking at design and the human body, and the laws that govern our world, I know there IS a God who created us and loves us. You can know Him too, if you come to Him humbly, realising that you are a sinner in need of a Saviour, and that there is *only one* Saviour, Jesus Christ. *Trust in Him today!*

If you are at the end of your life and *still* rejecting God, I would urge you to stop being so proud and stubborn, just for five minutes, and *think* and listen to what I am saying. What have you got to lose? Think again of the consequences, if what I have said is true, **Hell is a reality**.

Whatever stage you are at in life, look back for a moment; you're born, you grow up, make friends, go to school and start learning about life. You're now on a path that will shape you for the future.

Who you listen to, what you learn and who you follow, will influence you for the rest of your life. If you are educated 'out' of believing in God from the start, it is quite reasonable to say, that at the end of your life you'll have the same mind-set, am I wrong? Look at you now!

All I'm doing here is trying to wake you up to the reality that God exists, and we shall have to answer to Him

for the way we have lived. Death awaits us all, and what we have done with Jesus Christ (received Him or rejected Him), determines where we spend eternity.

I would be happy to correspond with you, and try to answer any questions you may have. I got saved, became a Christian, on May 4th 1989, and it was then that I found out the purpose of life.

Don't die in your sins alone, call upon the Lord to save you now, and let's see each other in Heaven.

That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. For the scripture saith, Whosoever believeth on him shall not be ashamed. Romans 10v9-11.

In whom we have redemption through his blood, even the forgiveness of sins. Colossians 1v14.

For the grave cannot praise thee, death can not celebrate thee: they that go down into the pit cannot hope for thy truth. Isaiah 38v18.
